White Water Rafting*:

On Tuesdays we go rafting from Sunbeam Village down the Salmon River for a half-day with White Otter Outdoor Adventures. White Otter generously makes it affordable to include a day of rafting in our camps. Unfortunately, parents are not invited to join our day of rafting. Parents may however arrange to go rafting with White Otter on their own.

Camp code of ethics:

We encourage kids to have fun, to respect others, and to communicate.

We do **NOT** tolerate swearing, rude, disruptive, or aggressive behavior. Campers who take away from other children's experiences will be asked to leave immediately.

Camp protocol:

At Galena, we try to work with our campers to resolve issues as they occur. For instance, if a child uses bad language our counselors will talk to the child, have the child apologize and warn the child that if this continues she/he will be asked to leave. Parents are not called at the first sign of trouble because we are not usually in the vicinity of a phone, and because we believe that teaching children to act responsibly in the absence of their guardians is a crucial part of growing up. If the child repeats the behavior- parents will be called as soon as possible and asked to pick up their child.

You can also fill out <u>one form per each child</u> of the following: Galena camp registration form and the Galena camp release & indemnity agreement. You also need to fill out the acknowledgement of risk form from White Otter Adventures and the horseback rideassumption of risk for Galena Stage Stop Corrals but you may put more than one child on these forms. Cancellations do occasionally occur. If dates indicated do not work out we will contact you and try to work out alternatives.
